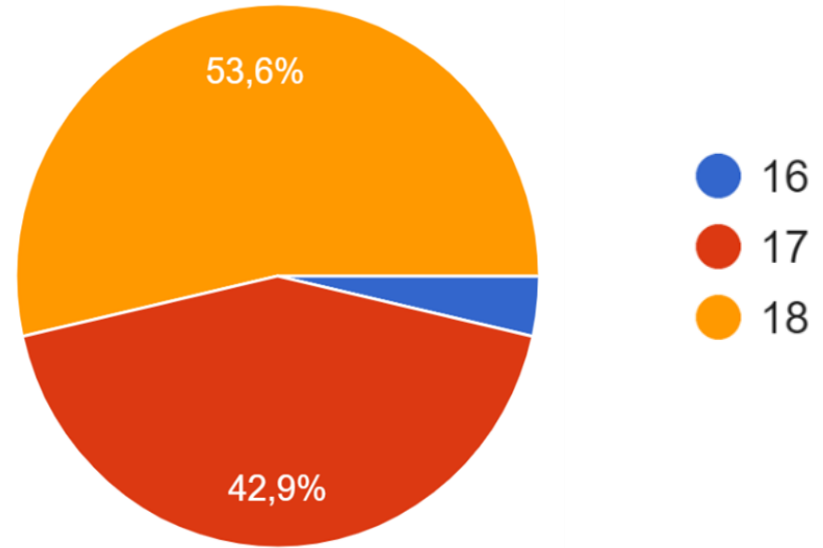

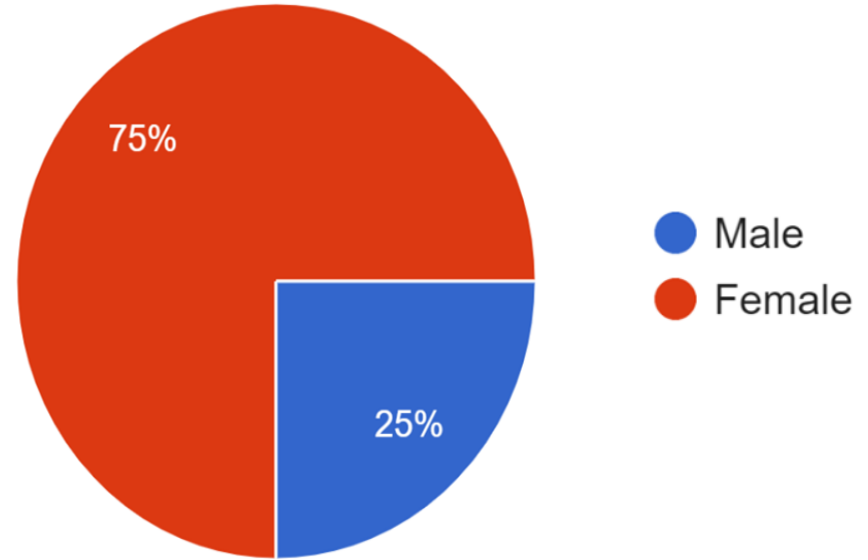

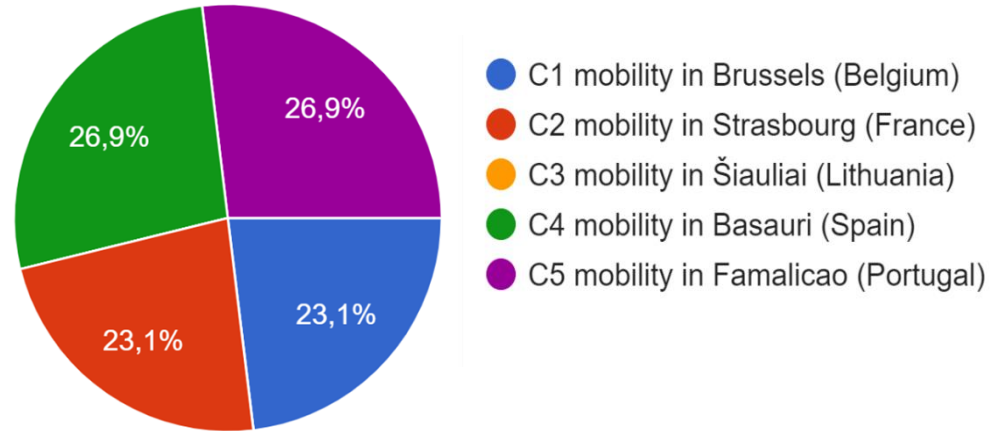
What led you to participation in the project? (give reasons)

- Mostly the IT part of Lithuania, the assembly of several videos, participating in those videos myself. Fully making a video about lithuanian history.

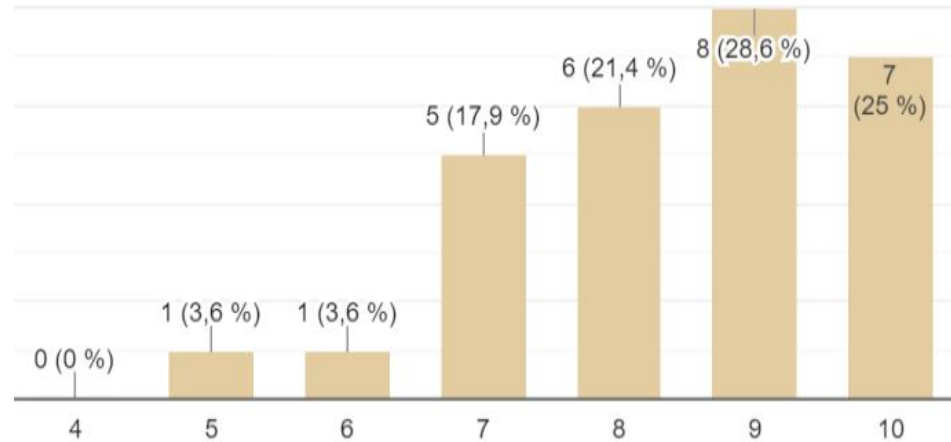
Name things you liked about this project

- I liked meeting new people who were extremely friendly and welcoming. Also I enjoyed taking part in different activities about democracy in different countries.

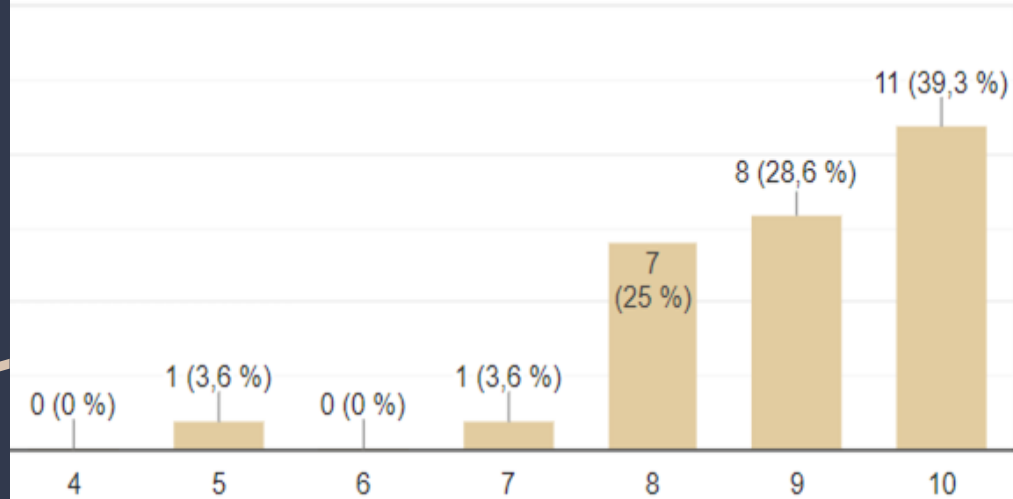
Name things you would change about this project

- I feel that the project could have had more international cooperation, more interaction among different nations, working in international teams more could have helped to get to know other cultures better.

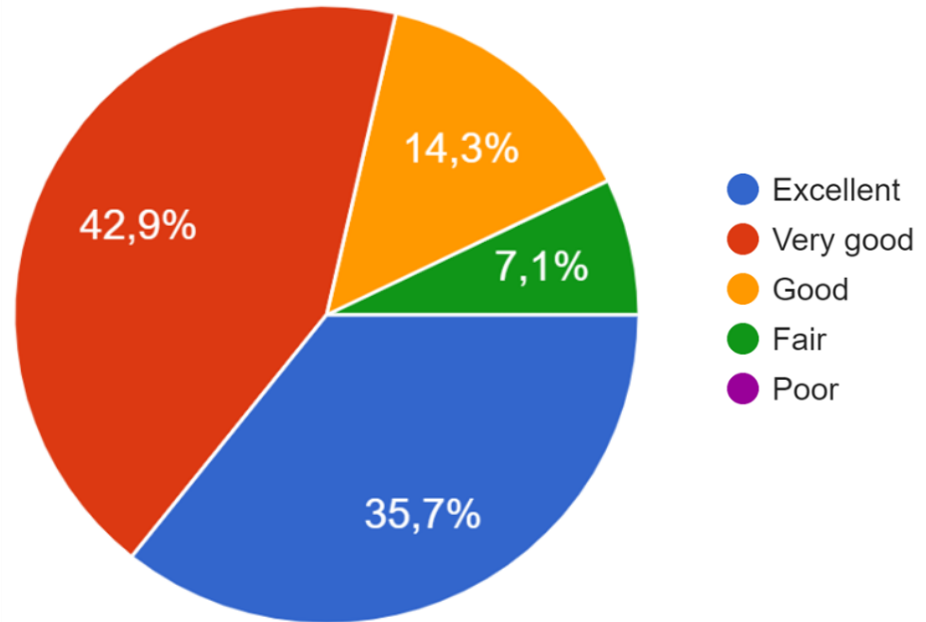
What was the impact of the project on citizenship education in the gymnasium?
