**I
GENERAL GUIDELINES**

1. Aim: to develop students’ creativity, self-realisation, to expand students’ knowledge on democracy.
2. Objectives:
 - 2.1. to develop values, respect and cooperation between students and teachers.
 - 2.2. to encourage children’s artistic performance, creative initiative, aesthetic taste, activeness.
 - 2.3. to initiate interaction and collaboration among students and teachers of different countries.
3. To organise exhibitions.

4. The participants of the exhibition – competition are students from all three schools taking part in the project “+ PARTICIPATORY DEMOCRACY, + ACTIVE CITIZENSHIP“

CONDITIONS OF SUBMITTING THE WORKS**

5. The technique can be various: drawing, painting, graphics or individual technique.
6. The drawing may depict anything that is connected with democracy – the freedom of speech, attitude, faith, partnership, choices, etc.
7. **The size of the work is A3 (297*420). On bottom right corner there must be a participant’s table – name, family name, form, school, teacher’s name (Annex 1).**
8. While submitting works the participants agree to publish their names on photographs.
9. The works must be submitted till October 31, 2020.
